Answer: PARTY HARD
Mostly, this is a fairly traditional "mangled clues" style puzzle; the only big change is that all R's have been replaced with L's across every clue. Find the transformation rules, decode the strings, solve for the clue words, then re-apply the undone transformation to each word. The result of each reapplication is the name of a fad dance with a single letter missing.
